Sub: Eligibility to appear in external theory examination—Reg.,

Respected Sir/Madam,

- 1. Last date for internal theory, internal practical & external practical online mark entry is 10th June 2019. The hall ticket will be made available to the students only on completion of above 3 categories of marks.
- 2. As per NBER Scheme of Examination 2018, a student is eligible to appear in final examination only after passing the internal examination in the concerned papers(theory/practical)
- 3. The concerned institutions may conduct re-examination of internal theory and practical examinations for the students who have failed or absent during the internal examinations, before the last date (10th June, 2019) scheduled by NIEPMD-NBER.
- 4. The marks of Internal Examinations conducted after the last date scheduled will not be considered under any circumstances.
- 5. The students who are absent or fail in the June 2019 Internal Theory Examination will be allowed to re-appear for Theory Examination only in December 2019 Supplementary Examination.
- 6. The students who are absent or fail in the June 2019 Internal Practical Examination will be allowed to re-appear for Practical Examination only in June 2020 Examination.
- 7. The students who are absent or fail in June 2019 External Practical examination will be allowed to re-appear for External Practical examination only in June 2020 examination in the concerned subject.
- 8. Hall ticket will be issued only to the students who have passed the internal theory and internal practical examination in the concerned subject.
- 9. If no marks are entered/blank or if the student is absent for internal theory and internal practical examination, the student will not be eligible for final examination and no hall ticket will be generated.
- 10. Internal theory, internal practical and external practical examination marks submitted after the last date (10th of June 2019) will not be considered.
- 11. As per NBER Scheme of Examination 2018, the final marks entered by the Course Coordinator for each paper will not be allowed to edit under any circumstances after the last date scheduled.
