Consequent upon the feedback received by the Council, some institutions apply and obtain permission to conduct CRE through webinar. However, the CRE webinars are not followed as prescribed in the Norms & Guidelines for CRE. Therefore, the basic objective of the CRE to upgrade knowledge and skills of rehabilitation professionals/personnel registered with RCI under Section 19 of the RCI Act, 1992 gets defeated.

2. Accordingly the Council has decided to discontinue the permission to conduct CRE webinar with immediate effect. Henceforth, only offline CRE programmes will be considered to accord approval. However, the permission already granted for online CRE programmes will continue.
